

“highway” means any cul-de-sac, boulevard, thoroughfare, street, road, **trail**, avenue, parkway, driveway, viaduct, lane, alley, square, bridge, causeway, ice-road, trestleway or other place, whether publicly or privately owned, any part of which the public is ordinarily entitled or permitted to use for the passage or parking of vehicles, and includes

- (a) a sidewalk, including a boulevard portion thereof,
- (b) when a ditch lies adjacent to and parallel with the roadway, the ditch,
- (c) when a highway right-of-way is contained between fences or contained in a cut-line or between a fence and one side of the roadway, all the land between the fences, all the land in the cut-line, or all the land between the fence and the edge of the roadway, as the case may be,
- (d) all the land shown on a registered plan of survey of a highway right-of-way,
- (e) when a highway right-of-way is not shown on a registered plan of survey or is not contained between fences or cut-lines, all the land within 30 metres of the centre line;
