

## **License Requirements**

The Motor Vehicle Act of Yukon requires snowmobiles to have valid registration.

A valid license plate must be fixed on the snowmobile and be visible.

To obtain registration and licence plate for a snowmobile the Motor Vehicles Department requires the following:

### **1. If the vehicle is brand new from a dealership (never registered)**

- The signed dealership Bill of Sale
- The original N.V.I.S. (New Vehicle Information Statement)
- Proof of valid insurance in the name(s) of the purchaser(s)

### **2. If the vehicle is being purchased used from a dealership**

- The signed dealership Bill of Sale
- Proof of valid insurance in the name(s) of the purchaser(s)

### **3. If the vehicle is being purchased from a private individual**

- A signed Bill of Sale from the vendor(s), all registered owners must sign the Bill of Sale
- Previous registration of the vendor showing them as the last registered owner(s)
- If the vendor did not register the vehicle, a copy of the dealership Bill of Sale instead of the vendor's registration
