Community Service Grant

Council makes grants available for utilities and property taxes to non-profit, religious and/or charitable Whitehorse organizations who are registered and in good standing under the Societies Act, and whose primary concern is to provide services to the needy members of the community of Whitehorse, including, but not limited to, the elderly, handicapped, low income, or special needs groups.

For events scheduled between July and December – **January 30** of each year

Municipal Services Grant

Provides grants for property taxes and other municipal charges to non-profit charitable and/or recreational organizations that lease municipally owned property. For information, contact the City at 667-6401.

Recreation Grants

Category 1 – Recreation Grant

Recreation Grant funding is offered to encourage volunteer community groups and organizations in Whitehorse to further improve or develop recreation opportunities for Whitehorse citizens. Funding support is available for program assistance, leadership development, capital, equipment and O & M.

Category 2 – Recreation Facilities / Parks

Funding may be available for use in ongoing operation and maintenance costs for non-City owned public recreation facilities. Funding is also considered for capital improvements and park enhancement projects. Funding support is available for capital and O&M costs.

Category 3 – Arts / Cultural Facilities

Funding may be available for use in ongoing operation and maintenance costs for non-City owned public facilities of an arts and / or heritage nature. Funding support is available for capital and O&M costs.

Deadline for Category 1: March 15 and September 15

Deadline for Category 2 and 3: March 15
