

Grey Mountain Cemetery Information 2017



I CEMETERY is a free download app available on IPHONES to view names, maps and available plots at Grey Mountain Cemetery

Plot, Interment and Monument Fees Include 5% gst

Plot Purchase Fee:\$689.00

One casket per plot plus an additional 4 urns following a casket interment or 5 urns per plot. Includes perpetual care and headstone placement of regular size monument. All plot preparation require a minimum notice to Parks and Community Development of two (2) working days from May 1 to September 30 and three (3) working days from October 1 to April 30.

Casket Interment Fees:

During normal business hours (Monday to Friday, 8:00 am – 4:00 pm)\$1610.25

After normal business hours\$2064.95

Note: Additional Fee in winter for casket interments (October 1 to April 30).....\$1741.10

Urn Interment Fees:

During normal business hours (Monday to Friday, 8:00 am – 4:00 pm)\$344.50

After normal business hours\$516.80

IMPORTANT – Monument Regulations as per Cemeteries Bylaw 2003-09

Regular Size Monument

The dimensions of a regular size monument shall not exceed 20cm (8”) in height, 75cm (30”) in width, and 30cm (12”) in depth. The cost for the placement of a regular size monument is included in the purchase of the plot.

Oversize Monument

Prior to purchasing an oversize monument, a written request from the customer to the City of Whitehorse must be submitted to the **Supervisor of Parks and Trails, Marc Boulerice**, for approval with a drawing or picture of the oversize monument showing the dimensions. The fees below will be charged for oversize monuments and must be paid prior to installation.

Oversize Monument Fee Upright to 24 Inches (must receive prior approval)\$227.75

Oversize Monument Fee Upright to 48 Inches (must receive prior approval)\$358.75

Monument placement outside of normal business hours Monday to Friday, 8:00 am – 4:00 pm will be subject to an additional charge.

As per Cemeteries Bylaw 2003-09

Item #20 - A monument shall be made of granite, marble or other suitable material commonly used for that purpose.

Item #21 - All monuments are considered to be the property of the purchaser and required care or repair is the responsibility of the purchaser. It is the responsibility of the purchaser to arrange for the delivery of the monument to the Cemetery for placement.

Item #22 - Only one monument shall be permitted on a plot unless written permission is obtained from the Supervisor.

Item #23 - A monument shall not be installed except by the Attendant.

Item #24 - No work shall be done upon any monument, nor shall the monument be removed from any plot without permission from the Supervisor.

Item #25 - A monument shall be installed on a base provided by the City or a base approved by the Supervisor.

****Common Monuments** (1 monument for 2 plots) are permitted side by side in some areas of the cemetery, however, there are areas this is not permitted. Please inquire prior to purchasing a plot. Side by side monuments are not permitted in "K" section. If you wish to have a common monument in this section, plots must be head to head. "R" section allows for 1 monument to be centered between two plots.

Plot Reservation and Assignment as per Cemeteries Bylaw 2003-09

Item #35 - A plot holder may request a transfer of the right of interment in a plot to a spouse or other family member by submitting the request in writing to the Supervisor.

Plot Ornament Information

At the time of interment, flowers and wreaths, adornments, standards, plants, artificial or otherwise may be placed on a plot but may be removed by staff when their condition is deemed to be detrimental to the general appearance of the Cemetery.

For the safety of maintenance staff and public, all breakable containers (glass, pottery and plastic) will be removed 30 days after an interment. In addition, ornament removal and disposal will be done bi-annually the first 2 weeks of May and last 2 weeks of September.

For the sake of environmental responsibility the City encourages the use of natural flowers to reduce the volume of waste going to the landfill.

Cemetery Hours: The Cemetery is open for walk in from 8:00 am – 11:00 pm daily. Vehicle access is available Monday to Sunday, from 8:00 am – 5:00 pm from May 1 to September 30.
