Introduce more complex skills as kids are ready.

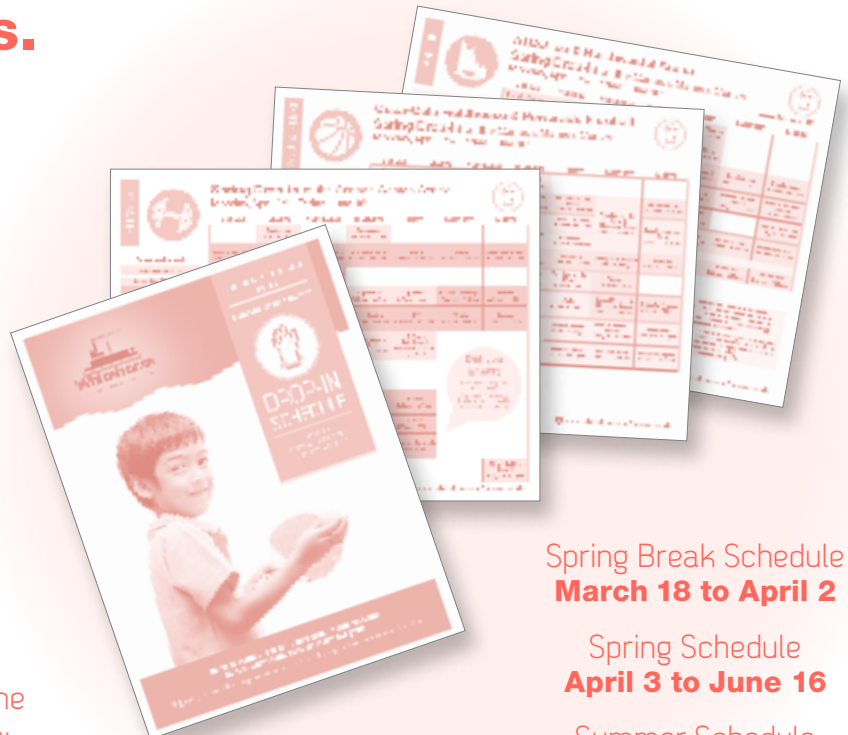

Rotary Peace Park

2045 - 2nd Avenue

This large open green space is ideal for spontaneous use and informal gatherings. Rotary Park is situated along the Riverfront Trail and is the first stop for the Whitehorse Waterfront Trolley at the south end of downtown.

Shipyards Park

100 - 1 Ogilvie Street

This premiere park for festivals and community events is located on the banks of the Yukon River.

Designed to be enjoyed year round, it is a large open space that lends itself to a multitude of activities. The Riverfront Trail passes through Shipyards Park at the north end of downtown and is also a stopping point for the Whitehorse Waterfront Trolley.
