Here are some popular trails:

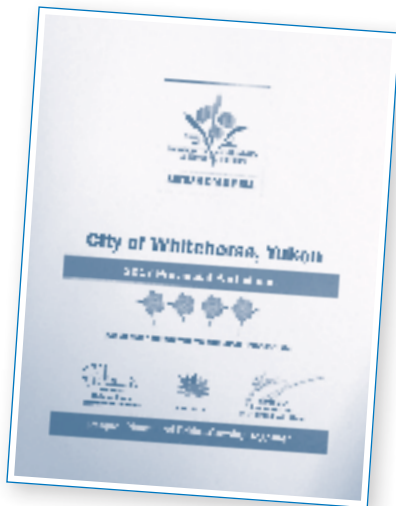
