



Purple Stew 2021 FAQ

We are so happy to welcome all our new and returning friends to Purple Stew and thought it would be helpful to provide some information that will hopefully answer some questions you might have.

What if my child is not the correct age at registration?

A child must be the correct age within a month of the start date of the program.

Does my child have to be fully toilet trained?

Yes, it is required for your child to be fully toilet-trained to attend our preschool programs. However, we understand accidents may happen and kindly ask that you please send your child with an extra set of clothes.

Which room at the Canada Games Centre does the program operate out of?

The Kids Club, located on the 1st floor concourse across from the Powerade® Flexihall.

What are some changes to Purple Stew that will continue this fall?

- Doors open at 9:00 am (morning session) and 12:30 pm (afternoon session).
- Families will not be allowed to enter the Kids Club. Drop off/Pick-up will be located on the 1st floor concourse in front of the Kids Club entrance. We encourage families to maintain physical distancing.
- Morning sessions are shortened by 15 minutes to allow for cleaning/disinfecting for afternoon sessions.
- Cleaning/disinfecting will happen three times a day.
- The Kids Club will follow an open floor concept allowing for increased space.
- We will continue to educate and encourage extra hygiene practices.
- The decision to wear a mask while attending our program is up to each child's parent/guardian.
- Children will have individual craft bags to use for their sessions.

Will I have to prescreen my child for COVID Daily?

YES - we are asking families to please screen their child each day for COVID-19 symptoms. A Daily Screening Questionnaire will be attached to our welcome email.

If my child is showing any signs or symptoms, can they still attend the program?

NO - we ask families to please keep their children home if they are sick to help keep our space as safe and healthy as possible.

What are some of the signs and symptoms of COVID?

- Fever/chills
- Cough
- Shortness of breath
- Runny nose
- Sore throat

What is the tentative daily schedule for Purple Stew?

Children must sanitize their hands before entering the Kids Club as well as when transitioning between each activity. Bathrooms will be cleaned daily, in between each session.
