

Easy to miss because it is not visible from the street, Dieppe playground offers lots of fun to younger kids. This small park is surrounded by trees on three sides, with the last open to a large wild grass meadow so kids have lots of room to run. One of the best viewpoints over Whitehorse is less than 30 metres from the playground boundary - a must see!
