

Set back from Thompson Road through a wooded border, Granger park got new equipment in 2010. The park area includes a skating rink with paved surface, a large soft lawn, trails through the trees, a pavillion, and plenty of play structures too! While toddlers may enjoy the swings and balance beams, older kids have lots to choose from for climbing, swinging and spinning.
