Please be advised that there will be a Public Hearing at the Special Council Meeting on 21 October 2013, to hear from interested parties related to the following proposed Local Improvement project:

Ogilvie Street West Reconstruction Project

The City of Whitehorse proposes to carry out reconstruction on Ogilvie Street from Fourth Avenue west to the escarpment. The work would include replacement of water, sewer and storm water infrastructure, improved fire protection flows and completion of paved roads with curb and gutter to city standards. Also included in the project is a new sidewalk along the south side of Ogilvie Street. Detailed design work would be done by consultants through the request for proposal process.

A local improvement charge to benefitting property owners would be applied to fund a portion of the surface works, in accordance with the LIC Bylaw and policy.

Bylaw 2013-46 received 1st Reading on 23 September 2013. Ballots were sent to benefitting property owners via registered mail on 26 September, and the accompanying letter notified of the public hearing date. A total of 54 ballots were mailed (one to each legally titled lot with frontage on streets receiving improvements). Ballots must be returned to City Hall on or before 1 November 2013.
