Named for: Bill Taylor, son of Isaac "Ike" Taylor

- Bill Taylor was a bookkeeper for the Taylor and Drury merchandising firm
- Later he ran Taylor Chev/Olds
- Ike Taylor came to the Yukon in 1898 from Yorkshire and opened the Taylor and Drury stores throughout the Yukon
- Came to Whitehorse in 1900 with the railway
