

## **Pioneer Hotel #2 (Hatch House)**

Address: Shipyards Park (Waterfront)

Built: circa 1899

Renovated:

- 1900—Relocated to Front Street (First Avenue)
- 1950's—Split from original structure

Designated: May 23, 2000

Named for: John Hatch

- Building was originally part of Savoy Hotel, located on east bank of Yukon River
- Was relocated to waterfront in 1900 and renamed Pioneer Hotel
- Was relocated again in 1950's to Moccasin Flats and original structure was split in three (Hatch House, Jenni House, and third structure that burnt down)



Current Use: Vacant

Past Use: Hotel and Residence
