

Cliffside Park is an older park set up against the clay cliffs in southern downtown. With views of the Yukon River, and occasional glimpses of eagles, foxes, and other urban wildlife, it offers a unique location for play. While older kids will enjoy the tire swing and various monkey bars circuits, toddlers can use the ride on toys and the swings.
