

This park is one of the largest in the city and is beloved by Whitehorse children. It is a very popular park and is often busy. Best-known as “Helicopter Park” because of the helicopter shaped climbing structure that has been at the park for many years, in the summer of 2012 the helicopter will be removed and an exciting new piece of equipment will be added.
