

Rinse containers




Remove lids




Cut down large boxes

→ Large cardboard recycling must be flattened and no larger than 91 cm x 91 cm Place neatly beside the bin.

#### Items that are not properly sorted and set out may not be collected.

**→** Each home is entitled to two blue bins and two yellow bags.
