

Council Questions – Standing Committee September 3, 2024

1. New Business – Dogs in Public Areas

a. What is the maximum number of dogs that can be owned by one person?

The Animal Control Bylaw contains the following maximums with some exceptions for veterinary clinics, licensed kennels or catteries, animal shelters, and accredited and registered special needs dogs.

- For properties zoned residential, there is a maximum of two dogs and two cats. A special permit may be issued to allow for a third dog or third cat. (Section 43 and 44)
- For properties zoned country residential, there is a maximum of four dogs and four cats. A special permit may be issued to increase the maximum to six dogs and six cats. (Section 47)
